ADDITIONAL MATTERS ORDER

The Worshipful Timothy John Briden Master, Master of Arts Bachelor of Law Chancellor of the Diocese and Official Principal of the Right Reverend Peter Hancock, Lord Bishop of Bath and Wells, having sought the advice of the Diocesan Advisory Committee, hereby makes an additional matters order, applicable to the whole Diocese in respect of the use of ecclesiastical premises, with the permission of the minister (or Area Dean during a vacancy) and churchwardens, for the purpose of vaccination centres during COVID-19, upon the following conditions:-

1. Permission shall be by way of a licence at will terminable by either party on 14 days' written notice.
2. No furniture, equipment or signage shall be fixed to the fabric.
3. Any directions given by the minister or churchwardens shall be observed.
4. The insurers of the ecclesiastical premises shall be notified.
